- Advertising
- Auto mileage (\$.37 per mile)/parking fees
- Bad debts from sales or services
- Business insurance
- Clothing: Beauty Coat/Red Jacket/Director's Suit
- Commissions and fees
- Depreciation on office equipment
- Dues and subscriptions
- Finance charges for business expenses/product ordered
- Gift set supplies (wrap, bags, baskets, ribbon, etc.)
- Legal and professional services
- Mary Kay event/training expenses
- Meals & Entertainment
- Mortgage interest/property taxes
- Office supplies & equipment
- On-Line services/MK web site expenses
- Personal product use
- Phone/cell phone
- Postage
- Repairs & Maintenance
- Sales Aids (also called Section 2 from the Consultant Order Sheet) Sales Aids
- Skin care class/facial supplies (cotton balls, applicators paper products, display items)
- Travel
- Non-recovered sales tax
